East Lyme's Overlook Park Progress Report #32

Wiese Construction & Environmental Construction Company, of Norwich, CT is the contractor responsible for the reconstruction of the western half of Overlook Park in Niantic, CT. You can view their progress on the internet from your computer if you connect it to the live webcam at: <http://publictrustfoundation.org/webcam.htm>.

The East Lyme Public Trust Foundation gave that webcam to the Town of East Lyme in 2006 for the purpose of enhancing security in the Park and to provide views on the internet of wave and tidal conditions on the beach. The webcam makes a 360° sweep along the coastline of Niantic Bay that takes it about 12 minutes to pan back to its starting position at Hole in the Wall. There it rests for about two minutes while showing you the underpass entrance to the Park. While at rest, its program is automatically refreshed. That permits it to then repeat its sweep. Once it starts its pan, you will see the work site in which Weise Construction is diligently reconstructing the new eastern walkway of the Park. Rest assured that the work is taking place under the watchful eye of the Construction Inspector who reports daily to the Design Engineer at Parsons Brinkerhoff in Boston, and the Town of East Lyme.

The accompanying photograph was taken at 1:52 pm on December 5, 2014, and gives an eastward view from a point approximately opposite Skippers Restaurant along Main Street (i.e. Route 156). At that time, a total of 183 sheet piles were in-place, which resulted in approximately 763 feet of steel bulkhead, or about 28% of the 2,750 feet needed to connect the eastern half of the walkway with the western terminus of the Park at Hole in the Wall underpass. The finished total length of this western half of the walkway will be 2,778 feet, of which 2,765 feet will be comprised of the steel sheet piles that form the bulkhead.
