East Lyme's Overlook Park Progress Report #45

The photograph above is of the new rededication monument in Niantic Bay Overlook Park, commonly called the "Boardwalk" The monument was reconstructed by the East Lyme Public Trust Foundation, as was the original monument constructed in 2005, at the Hole in the Wall railroad under pass. The new monument is 60 feet east of the under pass. It carries three plaques that credit those several individuals responsible for the key aspects of the project, which was conceived in 1994. Many obstacles were thereafter ultimately overcome and ground breaking took place on October 28, 2003. On July 15, 2005, the Ribbon Cutting Ceremony was addressed by Dedication Speaker, Gina McCarthy, Commissioner of the Connecticut Department of Environmental Protection. Connecticut Governor, M. Jodi Rell, officially proclaimed that day as the Niantic Bay Overlook Day in the State.

The plaque below is a tribute by the East Lyme Public Trust Foundation, Inc. to those who enabled the combined reconstruction of both eastern and western halves of the Boardwalk.
